Philosophy for Children – P4C



What is a definition of Philosophy for children? Philosophy is thinking about subjects such as morals, ethics, time, meaning and existence. Staff testing for Covid 19

As you may have heard in the media, starting from next week, staff will have the opportunity to access lateral flow testing for Covid 19. If a member of staff tests positive using one of these tests, they will then have a PCR test.
