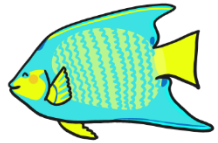


Home learning for Swallow class

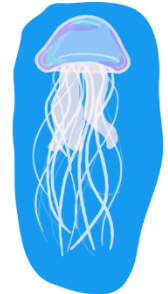
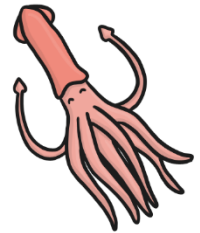
Are our oceans safe?
