

<u>Tour the city of Versaille</u>, starting at the palace.




Take a virtual tour of the world-famous <u>Pyramids of Egypt</u>. You can even see the Sphinx and inside the Mastaba Tombs.


Ignite your curiosity with a virtual walkthrough of London's Science Museum. You can also search their entire collection.
