

We will initially be continuing our work on the nonfiction narrative: Beatrice's Dream by Karen Lynne Williams. We will be revisiting areas such as noun phrases, conjunction use, fronted adverbials and working hard on creating interest through varied vocabulary. We will also be focussing on setting and character description.

We will work on creating play scripts from well known fairy tales such as Little Red Riding Hood, The Three Little Pigs and Jack and the Beanstalk.

Our Big Writes will focus on an item we would like to un-invent and a new school year.

R.E.



Our R.E. question for this term is 'How and why do people try to make the world a better place?' We will be finding out about some famous leaders, such as the Dalai Lama and Pope Francis, as well as thinking about how each of us can try to make the world a better place at home and at school.

Maths



Pupils will be working on presentation of data by creating and reading charts and tables.

We will also be working on estimation and checking calculations using the inverse.

Finally, we will look at coordinates and translation between points.

The year will conclude with consolidation of what has been learnt this year.

Science



This term we will be looking at sound. Children will learn how sound is made. They will also investigate how different materials reduce sound. They will consider the science behind volume change and how low and high pitch sound is made.
