

We will begin this term by working on information texts. We will be creating E-safety leaflets with the aim of improving pupils and parent's awareness of this important topic.

We will then move on to a non-fiction narrative: Beatrice's Dream by Karen Lynne Williams. We will be revisiting areas such as noun phrases, conjunction use and working hard on creating interest through varied vocabulary. We will also be focussing on setting and character description.

Our Big Writes for this term will also be focussing on character descriptions and story settings.

#### R.E.



Our R.E. unit this term is understanding how festivals and worship matter to a Muslim. We will be thinking about how a mosque is a special place of prayer and looking at the festivals of Ramadan and Eid-Ul-Fitr. We will think about how we can live more harmoniously. As part of our R.E. we will also be visiting Gloucester Cathedral and Mosque.

### Maths



Pupils will be continuing work on fractions. They will also work with money. Finally we will be working on areas the children have found challenging, to consolidate and deepen their understanding. There will also be mini maths sessions to consolidate their understanding of written methods of calculation in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also be looking at word problems. Times tables - we will continue our Club Maths, where pupils are working on improving their speed and accuracy, as well as continuing with the children's individual tables tests.

### Science



This term we will be looking at plants. Pupils will find out about the different parts of flowers and the role of bees in pollination. Pupils will also find out about the seeds; their role and why they vary in structure.

### Geography

We will be locating countries around the world and studying the human geography of Southwest England, Mexico and Spain.
