Dear Parents and Carers of Reception, Year 1 and Key Worker group,

Thank you for your patience over the past weeks. We are currently finalising our preparations to move forward to a gradual reopening and are looking forward to welcoming some of our Reception and Year 1 pupils, who haven't been with us recently, back to school.

Attached with this letter are: Home School Agreement and Frequently Asked Questions. Our updated home learning advice will follow shortly. On our website there are further documents including our Risk Assessment, updated Behaviour and First Aid policy plus links to government guidance and Local Authority documents.

**Please read, sign and return by email the attached home school agreement before your child starts back from 1<sup>st</sup> June.**

Key workers' provision remains in place for all families that need it. To accommodate a potential increase in number and ensure this provision matches the safety requirements we will split our key worker group into Year 2 and 3 pupils with Mrs Kirby in Goldfinch class and Year 4 – 6 with Mr Hanrahan in Swift class.

Provision is currently only available for those who stated that they wished for their child to return on 1<sup>st</sup> June on the questionnaire. If your child is in Reception or Year 1 and you replied 'No, Maybe or later in the term' on our questionnaire and you would now like your child to attend school, we will need one week's notice so that we can ensure adequate staff supervision and that pupils remain in small groups.
