Staggered start and end times:

Key worker group:	8.45 am – 3 pm	Please use middle gate on the field.
Reception:	9.15 am – 2.30 pm	Please use gate at the top corner of the playground.
Year 1:	9.00 am – 2.45 pm	Please use gate at top corner on the field.
Year 2 and 3:	9.00 am – 2.45 pm	Please use middle gate on the field
Year 4 and 5:	9.15 am – 3.00 pm	Please use middle gate on the field.

Where there are siblings, please choose the time convenient to you.

Days of attendance

Key worker group:	Monday – Friday
Reception:	Monday – Thursday
Year 1:	Monday - Thursday
Week commencing 6th July:	Year 3 and 5 Monday - Thursday
Week commencing 13th July:	Year 2 and 4 Monday - Thursday

What should we wear to school?

Children can wear winter or summer uniform or a mixture of both: white t-shirts and black shorts or similar if you are really struggling. We ask that all children wear their trainers/pumps to school from now until the end of term.

How do I stop germs transferring from home to school and back again?

Your child should only bring what they need for the day – a water bottle, their lunch (if they are not eating a school meal), a healthy snack and a coat as they will be spending as much time as possible outside. They should not bring backpacks, pencil cases, toys or home learning in from home.

What will happen for lunch?

Caterlink are providing a sandwich lunch that can be ordered each day. If you usually bring a packed lunch, please do so still. Lunchtimes will be staggered and children will sit at a distance when dining – this may be in the classroom, hall or outside. Children will need to wash their hands before and after lunch. Our aim is to, whenever possible, to eat outside in zoned areas.
